

An Ordinance of the City of Plano, Texas, amending Section 12-101, Prohibited on certain streets at all times, of Article V, Stopping, Standing and Parking, of Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the City of Plano Code of Ordinances, to establish no parking zones along certain sections of Columbia Place between Park Boulevard and 15th Street, within the city limits of the City of Plano; and providing a penalty clause, a repealer clause, a severability clause, a savings clause, a publication clause, and an effective date.

WHEREAS, Columbia Place is a thirty-six-foot-wide (36) collector street connecting Park Boulevard and 15th Street; and

WHEREAS, two traffic circles are located on Columbia Place, at Sacramento Terrace and at Brazos Trail, to help reduce vehicle speeds; and

WHEREAS, the reduced lane widths created by these traffic circles mean that parked vehicles in these areas could prevent motorists from safely maneuvering through the intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Engineering Division has evaluated both locations and recommends establishing no parking zones on both sides of Columbia Place at Sacramento Terrace and at Brazos Trail to ensure safe and efficient traffic flow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person to stop, stand, or park a motor vehicle along certain sections of Columbia Place, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer.

Section II. Section 12-101, Prohibited on certain streets at all times, of Article V, Stopping, Standing and Parking, of Chapter 12, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, of the City of Plano Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:

“Columbia Place:

- (1) Along both sides of Columbia Place between a point one hundred thirty-five (135) feet north of its intersection with Sacramento Terrace and a point one hundred thirty-five (135) feet south of its intersection with Sacramento Terrace.
- (2) Along both sides of Columbia Place between a point one hundred thirty-five (135) feet north of its intersection with Brazos Trail and a point one hundred thirty-five (135) feet south of its intersection with Brazos Trail.”

Section III. All provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Plano, codified or uncoded, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, and all

other provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Plano, codified or uncoded, not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV. It is the intention of the City Council that this Ordinance, and every provision hereof, shall be considered severable, and the invalidity or unconstitutionality of any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other portion of this Ordinance.

Section V. The repeal of any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance effectuated by the enactment of this Ordinance shall not be construed as abandoning any action now pending under or by virtue of such Ordinance or as discontinuing, abating, modifying, or altering any penalty accruing or to accrue, or as affecting any rights of the municipality under any section or provisions of any Ordinances at the time of passage of this Ordinance.

Section VI. Any violation of any provision or term of this Ordinance shall be a Class C misdemeanor offense. Any person, firm, corporation, or association who is adjudged guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor offense under this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$500.00) for each offense. Each and every violation shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.

Section VII. This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage and publication as required by law and after all necessary signs and pavement markings have been installed.
