

A Resolution of the City of Plano, Texas, amending Resolution No. 2025-7-10(R) that adopted the 2025-2026 Action Plan, including the summary of Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnerships Program activities and proposed use of funds for program year 2025-2026; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Community Relations Commission held meetings in 2025 on April 3, April 8, April 10, April 15 and April 17, and made final recommendations at a public hearing on April 22 concerning the 2025-2026 Action Plan which details the use of Community Development Block Grant Funds ("CDBG Funds") and HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds ("HOME Funds"), collectively referred to herein as the "Funds"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on July 28, 2025, to receive public comments concerning the recommendations of the Community Relations Commission; and

WHEREAS, after the close of the public hearing, the City Council approved the 2025-2026 Action Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and the related summaries, activities, and proposed uses of the Funds; and

WHEREAS, the summary of funding allocations in Resolution No. 2025-7-10(R) was incorrect and inconsistent with the approved 2025-2026 Action Plan approved by City Council, resulting in the need for adoption of an amendment to the resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION I. The summary of fund allocations in Section I of Resolution No. 2025-7-10(R) is hereby amended as follows:

City of Plano Grant Administration \$379,224

City of Plano Housing Rehabilitation \$1,059,515

City of Plano Homelessness Prevention \$122,000

City of Plano Tenant Based Rental Assistance Program \$168,195

Agape Resource and Assistance Center \$194,000

City House, Inc. \$31,595

Samaritan Inn \$61,983

Texas Muslim Women's Foundation \$36,983

Housing Channel \$419,281

SECTION II. All other provisions of and exhibits to Resolution No. 2025-7-10(R) remain the same.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
